# **Minutes Continued**

The Constitution and By-Laws were read and a motion was made by Monica to accept them as written. Dana seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Articles of Incorporation – There was a discussion regarding what state in which to incorporate. Charlene will pursue the least expensive state in which to incorporate. Charlene will be getting a Do Business As certificate based in Tarrant County. She will then set up the club's bank account.

Membership – There was a discussion on the amount of dues to charge members. Pat made a motion for dues to be \$20 per person and \$30 per family. The motion was seconded by Monica. The motion passed.

Club Equipment – Storage boxes, bandanas, and flags (10 sets of 12) have been purchased for future tracking tests. General consensus was to buy the pigskin leather gloves (\$3.99 per pair) from Northern Tool for future tracking tests. Each beginner student will get a starter set which includes 10 survey flags with carrying case, a bandana, and a glove. A starter set for the intermediate students will be determined at later date. All of the items above were purchased with the money collected from the summer classes.

Other business - Monica is working on the club logo.

Meeting adjourned at 6.p.m. The next meeting will be October 16, 2005 at 5pm at Spring Creek BBQ, I-20 and Wheatland, Duncanville.
