

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

**DIRECTIONS TO MATCH SITE:**

From Dallas:

Go north on I35E to HWY 183 West exit Amon Carter Blvd., left on Amon Carter, 4151 Amon Carter Blvd. , meet behind the AA Credit Union building near ATM's.

From Ft Worth:

Take HWY 183 East exit Amon Carter Blvd., right on Amon Carter, 4151 Amon Carter Blvd. ,meet behind AA Credit Union building near ATM's.

From Arlington:

Take Hwy 360 North, exit Trinity Blvd., right on Trinity Blvd., left on Amon Carter Blvd., 4151 Amon Carter Blvd., meet behind AA Credit Union building near ATM's.

**EXHIBITORS TAKE NOTE:** In an effort to avoid any unnecessary distraction during the test, we ask that each owner who is observing the test be responsible for his/her dog in regard to barking and other noise. Please keep all dogs who are not working inside your vehicle while in vicinity of the tracks. The AKC Tracking Regulations Chapter 1, Section 17 state: "Due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs shall be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site". A dog that is allowed to run free and off-lead, at any time before the test, during the test, after failing or after the completion of its' track, shall be failed and excused. If this occurs before the test, the dog shall be excused and not allowed to run in the test.

Please clean up after your pet.

There will be **NO** restroom facilities at the test site.

If it becomes necessary for any entrant to cancel please notify Match Secretary in writing as soon as possible so that the alternates may have a chance to fill your entry.

**ENTRY LIMITATIONS / TEST INFORMATION:** In accordance with AKC Tracking Regulations, entries in this test will be accepted up to the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limits may have been reached. This test is open to all registerable dogs at least 6 months of age. Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the test will be held Wednesday, February 21, 2007 at 8:00 p.m. at 1949 Kentwood Ln., Carrollton, TX 75007. This drawing will be conducted by the Treasurer and shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference shall be given to dogs that have not earned a certification, all remaining entries shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the Alternates List, subject to the same preferences set forth above. The Test Secretary shall then notify all entries of the results of the drawing.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent (see below), disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from participation by action of the Test Committee.

Bitches in season may participate per Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

Entry fees will be refunded for: (a) an alternate who does not participate, and (b) an entrant who is absent by virtue of earning the title after the close of entries, provided there is a properly entered alternate available to run the track. Refunds will be mailed within seven (7) days following the test.

In the event an accepted entry cancels following the closing of entries, the Test Secretary shall contact the alternates according to their placement on the Alternates List. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternative are present and, by their position on the Alternates List, determine which of the alternates shall participate. The assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges.

The DFW Tracking Club will exercise reasonable care for the safety of dogs competing, but will not be responsible for loss or damage or injury to any dog, handler, or property. Only dogs that are entered in the test will be allowed on the premises. Dogs will be required, at all times, to be on leash or crated.
