4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. ENTRY LIMITATIONS / TEST INFORMATION

CLOSING DATE for this TD test is February 26, 2009, 6:00 PM after which time entries cannot be accepted or changed. THIS TEST IS LIMITED TO FIVE DOGS.

ENTRY FEE: \$50.00 (includes \$0.50 AKC recording and \$3.00 Event Service Fees). Fees must be paid in U.S. Funds. Fees payable to **DFWTC**. Non-titles TD entries MUST be accompanied by original certification by an authorized AKC tracking judge.

ELIGIBILITY: All registered dogs at least 6 months of age and possessing the title of TD, TDX or VST, or dogs who have passed a certification track by an authorized AKC tracking judge.

ALL ENTRIES will be accepted until the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limits may have been reached. Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the test will be held on Thursday February 26, 2009 at 8:00 PM at 826 Indian Trail Argyle, TX 76226. This drawing will be conducted by the Test Secretary and shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference shall be given to dogs that have not earned a title, all remaining entries shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the Alternates List, subject to the same preferences set forth above. The Test Secretary shall notify all entries of the results of the drawing. The alternates will be asked to agree to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternates not selected will receive full refund of entry fees. DFWTC will also refund entry fees to any confirmed entry that does not participate in the test, provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the date of the test, and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of withdrawal. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent (see below), disgualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from participation by action of the Test Committee.

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate per Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED FOR: (a) an alternate who does not participate, and (b) an entrant who is absent by virtue of earning the title after the close of entries, provided there is a properly entered alternate available to run the track. Refunds will be mailed within seven (7) days following the test.

ALTERNATES: In the event an accepted entry cancels following the closing of entries, the Test Secretary shall contact the alternates according to their placement on the Alternates List. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternative are present and, by their position on the Alternates List, determine which of the alternates shall participate. The assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT will be mailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries. TEST INFORMATION CONTINUED

ALL ENTERED DOGS must be at Test Headquarters by 8:00 AM on March 8, 2009. A drawing will be held for track running order for each dog entered. The first tracks will be run as soon thereafter as is practical after the tracks have aged the proper length of time. In the event of any absentees among confirmed entries, the next alternate in catalog order who is present will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

BY THEIR PRESENCE on the Tracking grounds, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Test Committee to the best of their ability. The **DFW Tracking Club** will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of dogs, handlers, and spectators, but will **not** be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any dog or person on the test grounds. Chapter 1, Section 22, AKC Obedience Regulations: *"The owner or agent entering a dog in an obedience trial (tracking test) does so at his own risk..."* Only dogs that are entered in the test will be allowed in the Tracking area.

DOGS THAT ARE NOT ACTUALLY COMPETING will go where instructed and *all* dogs shall be "on lead" at all times in any area of the Tracking site. Dogs allowed to run free and "off lead" at any time before the test, during the test, after failing or after the completion of its track, shall be failed and excused. If this occurs before the test, the dog shall be excused and not allowed to run in the test. (Tracking Regulations Chapter 1, Section 16.) *Please clean up after your pet.*

REFRESHMENTS will be furnished on the morning of the test. A lunch is planned for after the completion of the test. Water will be available. Please note: there are no restroom facilities open at the test site.
