DIRECTIONS TEST HEADQUARTERS:

Directions from intersection of I-35 and loop 820 in north Fort Worth to the South Parking Lot, TCC Northwest Campus:

Take Loop 820 west to Exit 12A (Marine Creek Parkway). Turn right onto Marine Creek Parkway. Proceed north for 0.2 miles to Northwest College Drive. Turn left onto Northwest College Drive. Proceed 0.3 miles west and then turn left to enter the driveway to the south parking lot.

The AKC Tracking Regulations Chapter 1, Section 17 state: "Due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs shall be 'on lead' at all times on any area of the tracking site". A dog that is allowed to run free and off-lead, at any time before the test, during the test, after failing or after the completion of its' track, shall be failed and excused. If this occurs before the test, the dog shall be excused and not allowed to run in the test.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Please clean up after your pet. There will be NO restroom facilities at the test site.

If it becomes necessary for any entrant to cancel please notify Test Secretary in writing as soon as possible so that the alternates may have a chance to fill your entry.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS / TEST INFORMATION:

In accordance with AKC Tracking Regulations, entries in this test will be accepted up to the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limits may have been reached. This test is open to all registered dogs at least 6 months of age who possess the title of TD or who have passed a certification track by an authorized AKC tracking judge. Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the test will be held Thursday, November 19, 2009 at 8:00 p.m. CST at 8500 Prairie Rose Ln. Fort Worth, TX 76123. Public is invited. The drawing will be conducted by the Test Secretary and shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference shall be given to dogs that have not earned a title, all remaining entries shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the Alternates List, subject to the same preferences set forth above. An acknowledgement will be mailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries and after the drawing has been held. Should such an acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary at 817-370-9391 or deblyonsfw@sbcglobal.net. Acknowledgements may be obtained via e-mail by providing this address on your entry.

In the event an accepted entry cancels following the closing of entries, the Test Secretary shall contact the alternates according to their placement on the Alternates List. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present and, by their position on the Alternates List, determine which of the alternates shall participate. The assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges.

Bitches in season may participate per latest AKC Tracking Regulations.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from participation by action of the Test Committee. Entry fees will be refunded for: (a) an alternate who does not participate, (b) an entrant who is absent by virtue of earning the title after the close of entries, provided there is a properly entered alternate available to run the track, and (c) an entrant who withdraws in writing before the stated closing date/time. Refunds will be mailed within seven (7) days following the test.
