**TRACKING TEST INFORMATION
TEST LIMITED TO 5 TD ENTRIES**

CLOSING DATE: The closing date for this TD test is **March 4, 2010 at 6:00 PM** after which time entries cannot be accepted or changed.

ENTRY FEE: \$50.00 (includes \$0.50 AKC recording & \$3.00 Event Service fees). Fees must be paid in U.S. Funds. Fees payable to **DFWTC**. Non-titled TD entries **MUST** be accompanied by original certification by an authorized AKC tracking judge.

ELIGIBILITY: All dogs possessing the title of TD, TDX or VST, or dogs that have passed a certification track by an authorized AKC tracking judge are eligible to enter this test.

ALL ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. A drawing will be held on **Wednesday, March 4 at 6:00 PM** at the home of the secretary to determine which entrants will participate in the test. Entrants are invited to attend. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference will be given to untitled dogs. When the advertised limit has been drawn all remaining entrants, subject to the same preferences set forth in the preceding paragraph, shall be assigned a position on an alternate list corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The alternates will be asked to agree to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternates not used will receive full refund of entry fees. DFWTC will also refund entry fees to any confirmed entry that does not participate in the test, provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the date of the test, **and** provided that an alternate entry participates in test as result of withdrawal.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: An acknowledgement will be mailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries. Should such an acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary at **817-581-7351** or **taf76137@yahoo.com**. Acknowledgements may be obtained via email by providing your address on the entry submitted.

TEST HEADQUARTERS: 885 Slate Rock Road, Ennis, TX.

ALL ENTERED DOGS: Must be at Test Headquarters by **7:30 AM** on March 14, 2010.

Drawings will be held for track running order for each dog entered. The first tracks will be run as soon thereafter as is practical after they have aged the proper length of time. In the event of any absentee(s) among confirmed entries, the next alternate in catalog order who is present will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

BITCHES IN SEASON: A Bitch in season may participate subject to provisions set in the latest Tracking Regulations.

BY THEIR PRESENCE: All exhibitors and spectators on the Tracking grounds agree to abide by AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Test Committee to the best of their ability. Ch. 1, Sec. 22 AKC Obedience Regulations, "The owner or agent entering a dog in an obedience trial (tracking test) does so at his own risk..."

THE DFW TRACKING CLUB: DFWTC will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of dogs, handlers, and spectators, but will not be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any dog or person on the test grounds.

DOGS THAT ARE NOT ACTUALLY COMPETING will go where instructed and all dogs shall be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site. Dogs allowed to run free and off-lead, at any time before the test, during a test, after failing or after the completion of its track, shall be failed and excused. If this occurs before the test, the dog shall be excused and not allowed to run in the test. (Tracking Regulations Chapter 1, Section 16.)

REFRESHMENTS: Breakfast will be furnished on the morning of the test. A lunch is planned after the tests.

AWARDS: Each dog passing the Tracking Dog Test will receive an award commemorative of their track.

Directions from test headquarters:

Go west on Slate Rock Road for 1.7 miles. Turn left onto Stacks Road and proceed for 0.4 miles. Turn right onto FM 660W and travel for 7.8 miles. Turn right and merge onto I-45N. Take I-45N for 9 miles to Exit 267B. Merge onto I-20E and proceed east for 6.5 miles. Keep right to take I-635N via Exit 480. Travel on I-635N for 8.9 miles. Take Exit 8B to merge onto I-30E. Proceed 2.1 miles on I-30 to Exit 59 (Belt Line Rd – Broadway Blvd). Follow frontage road for 0.3 miles to Broadway Blvd. Turn right onto Broadway (which becomes Belt Line) and proceed south for 0.8 miles to clinic which is located on the right (west) side of the road.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
