NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

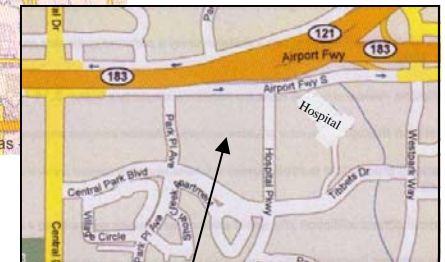
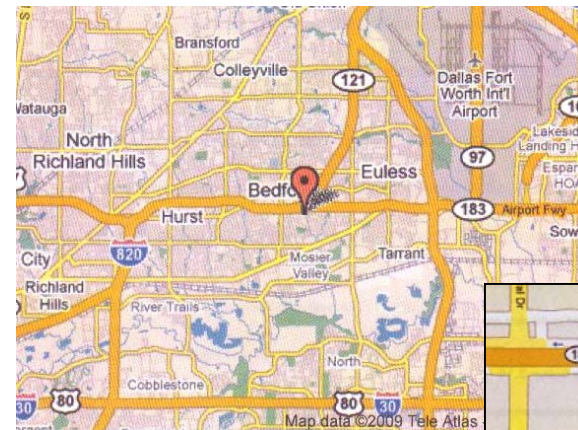
DOGS THAT ARE NOT ACTUALLY COMPETING will go where instructed and *all* dogs shall be "on lead" at all times in any area of the Tracking site. Dogs allowed to run free and "off lead" at any time before the test, during the test, after failing or after the completion of its track, shall be failed and excused. If this occurs before the test, the dog shall be excused and not allowed to run in the test. (Tracking Regulations) In an effort to avoid any unnecessary distraction during the test, we ask that each owner who is observing the test be responsible for his/her dog in regard to barking and other noise. All dogs who are not working should be kept inside your vehicle while in the vicinity of the tracks.

Please clean up after your pet.

**DIRECTIONS TO TEST HEADQUARTERS**—Harris Methodist HEB Hospital.

From Dallas: HWY 183 West and exit at Central Blvd. Go under the highway and east on south service road. Turn right onto Hospital Parkway and right into the Physicians' Building parking lot.

From Fort Worth: HWY 820 East to HWY 183 East. Exit Central Blvd and go through the light to continue on south service road. Proceed as above.

TEST INFORMATION CONTINUED

ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED FOR: (a) an alternate who does not participate, and (b) an entrant who is absent by virtue of earning the title after the close of entries, provided there is a properly entered alternate available to run the track. Refunds will be mailed within seven (7) days following the test.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: The Test Secretary will notify exhibitors by e-mail after the closing of entries and after the drawing has been held. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary at **940-464-4027** or by e-mail at **berrybar15@verizon.net**. Please provide an e-mail address on your entry form. If it becomes necessary for any entrant to cancel please notify the Test Secretary as soon as possible so that the alternates may have a chance to fill your entry.

STARTING TIME: All entered dogs must be at Test Headquarters by **8:45 AM** on January 17, 2010. A drawing will be held for track running order for each dog entered. The first tracks will be run as soon thereafter as is practical after the tracks have aged the proper length of time. In the event of any absentees among confirmed entries, the next alternate in catalog order who is present will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

BY THEIR PRESENCE: On the Tracking grounds, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Test Committee to the best of their ability. **DFW Tracking Club** will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of dogs, handlers, and spectators, but will **not** be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any dog or person on the test grounds. AKC Obedience Regulations: *"The owner or agent entering a dog in an obedience trial (tracking test) does so at his own risk..."* Only dogs that are entered in the test will be allowed in the Tracking area. Dogs will be required, at all time, to be on leash or crated.

REFRESHMENTS: Coffee and light pastries will be available on the morning of the test. A lunch is planned following the completion of the test. Water and ice tea will be available. Awards will be presented during the lunch.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS / TEST INFORMATION

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee) must be paid in U.S. funds. Fees payable to **DFWTC**. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from participation by action of the Test Committee (see exceptions below).

CLOSING DATE: This test will close at **6:00 PM** on **Wednesday, January 6, 2010**. Entry is limited to eight (8) dogs. In accordance with AKC Tracking Regulations, entries in this test will be accepted up to the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limit may have been reached. **Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the test will be held Wednesday, January 6, 2010 at 8:00 p.m. at 826 Indian Trail, Argyle, TX 76226.** This drawing will be conducted by the Test Secretary and shall be completely random among all entries received. The draw for tracks shall be conducted with untitled dogs until the available tracks have been filled. All remaining dogs will be drawn for positions on the alternates list with untitled dogs being drawn first followed by titled dog entries. Untitled dogs will have priority for the draw in all tests. Alternates will be given the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternates list. Those who accept will be placed on the alternates list in the order in which they were drawn. Those who opt to decline will have their entry fees and certification returned.

ELIGIBILITY: All registered dogs at least 6 months of age and have earned a TD title. **Bitches in season may participate** as stated in the latest AKC Tracking Regulations.

ALTERNATE LIST: Dogs on the Alternate List will be asked to agree to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternates not selected will receive full refund of entry fees. DFWTC will also refund entry fees to any confirmed entry that does not participate in the test, provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the date of the test, and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal.

ALTERNATES: In the event an accepted entry cancels following the closing of entries, the Test Secretary shall contact the alternates according to their placement on the Alternates List. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present and, by their position on the Alternates List, determine which of the alternates shall participate. The assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
