Go west on Slate Rock Road for 1.7 miles. Turn left onto Stacks Road and proceed for 0.4 miles. Turn right onto FM 660W and travel for 7.8 miles. Turn right and merge onto I-45N. Take I-45N for 9 miles to Exit 267B. Merge onto I-20E and proceed east for 6.5 miles. Keep right to take I-635N via Exit 480. Travel on I-635N for 8.9 miles. Take Exit 8B to merge onto I-30E. Proceed 2.1 miles on I-30 to Exit 59 (Belt Line Rd – Broadway Blvd). Follow frontage road for 0.3 miles to Broadway Blvd. Turn right onto Broadway (which becomes Belt Line) and proceed south for 0.8 miles to clinic which is located on the right (west) side of the road.


DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE Bristol Boarding Kennel 1009 Slate Rock Road, Ennis TX

From the North:

Take I-45 south to exit 266 (FM 660/5th Street) in Ferris. Stay on the service road to E. 8th Street and turn left on FM 660 East. Follow FM 660 for 7.8 miles. Turn left on Stacks Road. Turn right on Slate Rock Road. Follow Slate Rock Road for 1.9miles. Turn left into Bristol Boarding Kennel.

From the South:

Take I-45 north to exit 255 (FM879) in Ennis. Turn right on FM 879 (east) and follow for 5.3 miles. Turn right on FM 813 (east) and follow for 1.2 miles. Turn left on FM 660 (north) and follow for 1.2 miles. Continue Straight on Stacks Road (FM 660 will make a sharp turn left, but you will go straight). Turn right on Slate Rock Road. Follow Slate Rock Rod for 1.9 miles. Turn left into Bristol Boarding Kennel.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS / TEST INFORMATION

CLOSING DATE for this TDX test is March 3, 2011, **6:00 PM CST** after which time entries cannot be accepted or changed. **THIS TEST IS LIMITED TO FOUR DOGS.**

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 (includes \$0.50 AKC Recording and \$3.00 Event Service Fees). Fees must be paid in U.S. Funds. Fees payable to **DFWTC**. Mail to Nancy Barclay, 826 Indian Trail, Argyle, TX 76226. There will be a charge for returned checks.

ELIGIBILITY: All registered dogs at least 6 months of age and possessing the title of TD, TDX or VST.

ALL ENTRIES will be accepted until the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limits may have been reached. Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the test will be held on Thursday March 3, 2011 at 8:00 PM CST at 826 Indian Trail Argyle, TX 76226. The public is invited. This drawing will be conducted by the Test Secretary and shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference shall be given to dogs that have not earned the TDX title. All remaining entries shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the Alternates List, subject to the same preferences set forth above. The Test Secretary shall notify all entries of the results of the drawing, giving the alternates the option of being removed from the Alternates List. Alternates not running a track will receive full refund of entry fees. DFWTC will also refund entry fees to any confirmed entry that does not participate in the test, provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the date of the test, and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of withdrawal. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent (see below), disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from participation by action of the Test Committee.

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate per Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED FOR: (a) an alternate who does not participate, and (b) an entrant who is absent provided there is a properly entered alternate available to run the track. *Cancellation* of an entry must be made in writing and received prior to the closing date and time for this test. Refunds will be mailed within seven (7) days following the test.

ALTERNATES: In the event an accepted entry cancels following the closing of entries, the Test Secretary shall contact the alternates according to their placement on the Alternates List. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine from the alternates present, according to the order on the Alternates List, which alternate will participate in the draw. The assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT will be mailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries. TEST INFORMATION CONTINUED

A DRAWING WILL BE HELD FOR TRACK RUNNING ORDER at test Headquarters at Bristol Boarding Kennel, 1009 Slate Rock Road, Ennis, TX at 10:00 a.m. CDT* on the date of the test. The first tracks will be run as soon thereafter as is practical. In the event of any absentees among confirmed entries, the next alternate in catalog order who is present will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

BY THEIR PRESENCE on the Tracking grounds, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Test Committee to the best of their ability. The **DFW Tracking Club** will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of dogs, handlers, and spectators, but will **not** be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any dog or person on the test grounds. Chapter 1, Section 6 of the AKC Tracking Regulations: "The owner or agent entering a dog in an obedience trial (tracking test) does so at his own risk..."

DOGS THAT ARE NOT ACTUALLY COMPETING will go where instructed and all dogs shall be "on lead" at all times in any area of the Tracking site. Dogs allowed to run free and "off lead" at any time before the test, during the test, after failing or after the completion of its track, shall be failed and excused. If this occurs before the test, the dog shall be excused and not allowed to run in the test. (Tracking Regulations Chapter 1, Section 16.) Please clean up after your pet.

REFRESHMENTS A lunch is planned for after the completion of the test. Water will be available. Restrooms are available.

THE DFW TRACKING CLUB will exercise reasonable care for the safety of dogs competing, but will not be responsible for loss or damage or injury to any dog, handler, or property. Dogs will be required, **at all times**, to be on leash or crated.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have the appropriate vaccinations.

AWARDS: Each dog passing the test will receive an award commemorative of the track.
