
Fossil Ridge Ranch is located in Valley View, Texas and is approximately 6 miles off of I-35, between Sanger and Gainesville, TX.

FROM THE NORTH

- Take I-35 south to Exit 491
- Turn right (west) onto CR-202 and drive 2 miles
- Turn left (south) onto CR-207 and drive 0.5 miles
- Turn right (west) onto CR-386 and drive .7 miles to Fossil Ridge Ranch

FROM THE SOUTH

- Take I-35 north (of Denton) and take Exit 487 to FM-922
- Turn left (west) onto FM-922 and drive 1.9 miles
- Turn right (north) onto CR-207 and drive 1.7 miles (eventually curving to the left (west)

ENTRY INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY: All AKC-registered dogs that have earned a TD title are eligible to enter this test. In addition, all AKC-registered dogs not less than 6 months of age that have passed a certification track by an authorized AKC tracking judge may enter provided that an original certification dated within the last 12 months is included with the entry and fee. Dogs may enter this test after having already earning the title for the entered test, but priority in drawing for participants will be given to dogs not yet having earned that title.

EXCHANGING TRACKS: If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged, up to the day of plotting. The following substitution will be in effect: 2 TD's = 1 TDX (AKC *Tracking Regulations*, Chapter 1, Section 13(a)).

ENTRY FEE: TDX entry fee of \$110.00 or TD entry fee of \$60 (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee) must be paid in U.S. funds, payable to **DFWTC**. DO NOT send entries by any service that requires a signature for delivery. VERIFY that your carrier will deliver to a PO Box. No fax or phone entries allowed.

EMAIL NOTIFICATION of entry received will be sent to each entrant by the Test Secretary as soon as possible, as long as an email address is provided on the entry form.

CLOSING/DRAWING FOR TEST PARTICIPANTS: This test will close at 6:00 pm CDT on Thursday, November 1, 2012, The entry is limited to four (4) TDX dogs and (4) TD dogs. In accordance with AKC Tracking Regulations, entries in this test will be accepted up to the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limit may have been reached. Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the test will be held Thursday, November 1, 2012 at 6:30 p.m. CDT at Dickey's Barbeque Pit, **2919 Forest Lane, Dallas, TX 75234.** This drawing will be conducted by the Test Secretary and shall be completely random among all entries received, except that the draw shall be conducted with dogs without the title for which they have entered until the available tracks have been filled. All remaining dogs will be drawn for positions on the alternates list with dogs without the title for which they have entered being drawn first. Alternates will be given the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternates list. Those who accept will be placed on the alternates list in the order in which they were drawn. Those who decline will have their entry fees returned.

TEST INFORMATION

PRACTICING AT THE TEST SITES: No entered dogs should be on the test site within 3 days of the test. Only test officials and personnel may be at the test site the day prior to the event.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE provided the Test Secretary is notified prior to the drawing of tracks (AKC *Tracking Regulations*, Chapter 2, Section 8).

DRAWING FOR TRACKING ORDER: The **drawing for tracking order** will be held at the Test Headquarters. The drawing for **TD** tracks will be at 7:30 a.m. and the drawing for **TDX** tracks at 9:30 a.m. on November 11, 2012. The assignment of dogs to the tracks is the responsibility of the judges.

REFRESHMENTS: Coffee and light pastries will be available on the morning of the test. A lunch is planned following the completion of the test. Water and ice tea will be available. Awards will be presented during the lunch.

EXHIBITORS AND THEIR DOGS MAY NOT BE ABLE TO DRIVE THEIR OWN VEHICLE TO THE START OF THEIR TRACK. This may apply to some TD and/or TDX tracks.

ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED FOR: (a) an alternate who does not run in the test, and (b) a dog drawn into the test that does not run, provided a properly entered alternate runs in their place. Refunds will be mailed within seven (7) days following the test.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from participation by action of the Test Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot be held or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike and/or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or Test Secretary.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIANS' RECOMMENDATION to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

BY THEIR PRESENCE on the Tracking grounds, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Test Committee to the best of their ability. **DFW Tracking Club** will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of dogs, handlers, and spectators, but will **not** be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any dog or person on the test grounds. AKC Obedience Regulations: "The owner or agent entering a dog in an obedience trial (tracking test) does so at his own risk..." Only dogs that are entered in the test will be allowed in the Tracking area. Dogs will be required, at all times, to be on leash or in a vehicle.
