MY FIRST TDX DOG!!!!! By Mrs. Gillian M. Salling

I had been watching the weather forecast for ten days before the DFW Tracking Club's TDX test on March 11th, 2012, because it kept mentioning rain that weekend. I was afraid the judges would not be able to plot the tracks on the Saturday and also that the test would be canceled due to storms. I had decided that if it was pouring with rain that morning that I just would not go. Fortunately, it was only light rain and the radar didn't look too bad so I decided to load up the two dogs I had entered and leave.

However, before I got out of Sherman, it started raining heavily so I was really wondering if I had made the right decision! Luckily the rain did lessen but it was not easy driving as there was a lot of water on the roads.

My first GSD who was entered, Greta von Fernheim TD BH, drew the first track but after doing a very commendable job in the light rain and working very hard, she overshot the second to last turn so that was a huge disappointment since I knew she was already almost 9 1/2 years old. But since she did so well, I was really hoping my other girl, Liesl von Fernheim TD HCT, would be successful. Liesl had first tried for her TDX a year earlier and had done well until she went off on the second set of cross tracks so I was hoping those would not be a problem this time.

Liesl was the first alternate so she had to do the last track of the day after the 4 others. It was no longer raining and there was a light wind but the temperature was pleasant. Liesl's first leg went in an area where there was some prickly pear on each side of the track. I had not tracked her around cactus before so I was hoping she would not have a problem with that. But she appeared to be on a roll so off we went!

Her second leg went into some longer brushy vegetation so I made sure to get close behind her and gather up my line so that I would not get tied up as I did on Greta's track! After we came out of that, the track meandered around the thickest part of the woods, which is

a bit disconcerting if you mostly track in straight lines, but I had worked Liesl on some of those tracks and she was telling me she was on track. I was also concerned on this leg as it went past the kennels next to the house but Liesl was not distracted by them or the smells there.



After the next turn she set off in a straight line for several yards and then lay down perfectly straight in an article indication that the Schutzhund people love to see! I went up to her and held up a tie, which was the first article, so now I was starting to feel pretty confident! I knew that Liesl would not be interested in waiting long enough to get a drink of water, so I restarted her and off we went again towards the road, where she hesitated momentarily but then

crossed it and set off again at a good fast pace.

She apparently then went over the first cross tracks without getting distracted and got to the next turn and started on the next leg. There was another set of cross tracks which did not pose a problem to her and she continued to the next turn and turned left again. She continued at her fast pace and then all of a sudden did another perfect straight down article indication! I went up to her and picked up a cap, so

now I was starting to get a little excited! She then continued on towards the road again and I had been warned that if I saw a pickup stuck on the road in the mud to not worry and just ignore it. The track did go fairly near the truck and Liesl did look at it, but then she put her nose back again and crossed over the road and headed towards some cedar trees. I was a little nervous at that point as I knew that there could be some tracks there from various wild life. As she got near the trees she did check out a couple of smells and then made an open turn to the right leading away from the trees. The track angled a bit but then all of a sudden I saw something yellowish in front of Liesl and once again she did a perfectly straight down article indication!!!!! I went up to her and raised that coveted TDX glove and shouted with glee!!! Jeff Shaver asked me how long I thought that track was and I said, "Oh, probably 830 or 840 yards" and he replied, "985 yards and she did it in only 20 minutes!!!!!!" Well, I knew she was going fast but I had no idea the track had been that long! So when Jeff signed her glove he



wrote, "985 yards of perfection!" It was a great tribute to Liesl and quite a coincidence in that he had been one of the judges when she got her TD! So a big thank you to Jeff and to Linda Baschnagel for helping me obtain the first TDX title that one of my GSDs has earned and thanks so much to the DFW Tracking Club and all of its dedicated hard working members! I'm so happy that I got my first TDX at your club's test!
