

DIRECTIONS TEST HEADQUARTERS

From the North:

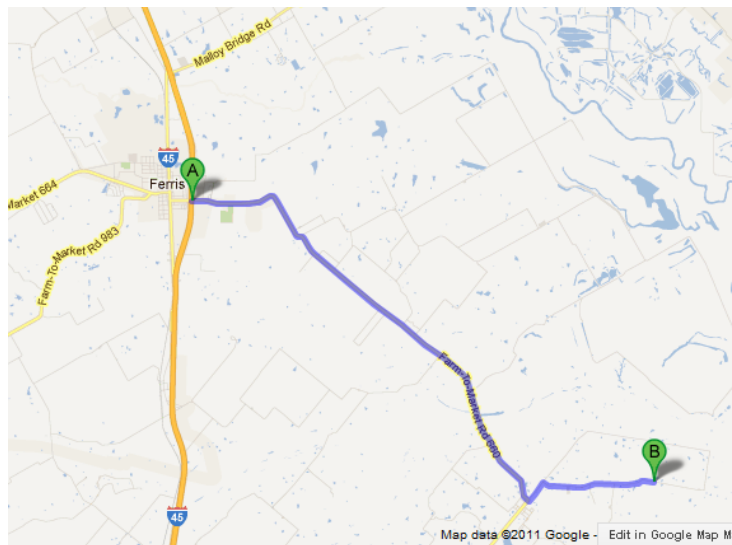
Take I-45 south to exit 266 (FM 660/5th Street) in Ferris. Stay on the service road to E. 8th Street and turn left on FM 660 East. Follow FM 660 for 7.8 miles. Turn left on Stacks Road. Turn right on Slate Rock Road. Follow Slate Rock Road for 1.9 miles. Turn left into Bristol Boarding Kennel.

From the South:

Take I-45 north to exit 255 (FM879) in Ennis. Turn right on FM 879 (east) and follow for 5.3 miles. Turn right on FM 813 (east) and follow for 1.2 miles. Turn left on FM 660 (north) and follow for 1.2 miles. Continue Straight on Stacks Road (FM 660 will make a sharp turn left, but you will go straight). Turn right on Slate Rock Road. Follow Slate Rock Rod for 1.9 miles. Turn left into Bristol Boarding Kennel.

EMERGENCY VET

Go west on Slate Rock Road for 1.7 miles. Turn left onto Stacks Road and proceed for 0.4 miles. Turn right onto FM 660W and travel for 7.8 miles. Turn right and merge onto I-45N. Take I-45N for 9 miles to Exit 267B. Merge onto I-20E and proceed east for 6.5 miles. Keep right to take I-635N via Exit 480. Travel on I-635N for 8.9 miles. Take Exit 8B to merge onto I-30E. Proceed 2.1 miles on I-30 to Exit 59 (Belt Line Rd – Broadway Blvd). Follow frontage road for 0.3 miles to Broadway Blvd. Turn right onto Broadway (which becomes Belt Line) and proceed south for 0.8 miles to clinic which is located on the right (west) side of the road.

DRAWING FOR TRACKING ORDER: The drawing for tracking order will be held at 10:00 AM CDT on March 11, 2012 at the Test Headquarters. The assignment of dogs to the tracks is the responsibility of the judges. Please note Sunday begins Daylight Saving Time and clocks are moved forward 1 hour.

EXHIBITORS TAKE NOTE: The DFW Tracking Club will exercise reasonable care for the safety of dogs competing, but will not be responsible for loss or damage or injury to any dog, handler, or property.

ENTRY INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY: This test is open to all AKC-registered dogs at least 6 months of age who possess an AKC tracking title.

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee) must be paid in U.S. funds, payable to DFWTC. DO NOT send entries by any service that requires a signature for delivery. No fax or phone entries allowed.

EMAIL NOTIFICATION of entry received will be sent to each entrant by the Test Secretary as soon as possible, as long as an email address is provided on the entry form.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: Draw order will be mailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries. Should such an acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within reasonable time, please notify the Test Secretary at 817-846-5222 or crdslabs@yahoo.com. Acknowledgements may be obtained via email by providing your email address on entry.

CLOSING/DRAWING FOR TEST PARTICIPANTS: This test will close at 6:00 pm CST on Thursday, March 1, 2012. The entry is limited to four (4) dogs. In accordance with AKC Tracking Regulations, entries in this test will be accepted up to the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limit may have been reached. Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the test will be held Thursday, March 1, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. CST at the McFalls Building – Cottonwood Park, 1300 SW 3rd Street Grand Prairie, TX 75051. This drawing will be conducted by the Test Secretary and shall be completely random among all entries received; except that the draw shall be conducted with dogs without the TDX title will be given preference until the available tracks have been filled. All remaining dogs will be drawn for positions on the alternates list with dogs without the TDX title being drawn first. Alternates will be given the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternates list. Those who accept will be placed on the alternates list in the order in which they were drawn. Those who decline will have their entry fees returned.

TEST INFORMATION

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE provided the Test Secretary is notified prior to the drawing of tracks (AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 8).

REFRESHMENTS: Coffee and light pastries will be available on the morning of the test. A lunch will be held following the completion of the test. Water and iced tea will be available. Awards will be presented during the lunch.

ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED FOR: (a) an alternate who does not run in the test, and (b) a dog drawn into the test that does not run, provided a properly entered alternate runs in their place. Refunds will be mailed within seven (7) days following the test.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from participation by action of the Test Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot be held or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike and/or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or Test Secretary.

WITHDRAWAL: If it becomes necessary for any entrant to withdraw please notify the Test Secretary in writing as soon as possible so that an alternate may have a chance to fill your entry.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIANS' RECOMMENDATION to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

BY THEIR PRESENCE on the Tracking grounds, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Test Committee to the best of their ability. DFW Tracking Club/Bristol Boarding Kennel will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of dogs, handlers, and spectators, but will not be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any dog or person on the test grounds. AKC Obedience Regulations: "The owner or agent entering a dog in an obedience trial (tracking test) does so at his own risk..." Only dogs that are entered in the test will be allowed in the Tracking area. Dogs will be required, at all times, to be on leash or in a vehicle.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
