Shevy's TD Title

I started Shevy in tracking to "get my feet wet" so to speak. In 30+ years of training and showing my dogs – the one real lesson to be learned is – you usually screw up the first dog you train in any new venue. And so Shevy started tracking with the sole purpose – to be screwed up. The goal was to learn what I could and then move to Romance.

The plans went astray when Romance got sick. Back to Shevy – because by now I enjoyed the social aspect of tracking.

Shevy got mammary cancer – a spay and some "removals" were needed. Back to Romance since he was well. Again Romance got sick (there could be a pattern here) and so back to Shevy after a long layoff.

By now I had figured out tracking was not in Romance's future. So I was STUCK with Shevy.

Since most of you don't know her – that statement probably sounds awfully mean. Shevy is one in a million. She makes me laugh when no one else can, makes me cry to keep me humble, and does what she wants when she wants. Just about the happiest dog you will ever know.

Shevy is the smartest dog I have ever bred/owned. I love her dearly – but to think about seriously trying for a TD – I was worried. Would she ever do it my way? Or Cindi's way? Or more important – the AKC way? I was pretty sure we would do it Shevy's way – or not at all.

After 5 attempts to certify – we finally did – at an elementary school in Weatherford – with 4 days to spare to enter the DFW Tracking Test November 10th.

The draw was done and THANK HEAVEN we did not get the first track. I needed to get the jitters out and watching another dog was a great start. Second was perfect. Watch one and then go. It was wonderful to see the first dog pass. Made one feel the conditions were right for tracking!

Bad news? The conditions were perfect for BIRD HUNTING too. There were many – especially the judges I expect – who thought I had lost my mind when in the first 30 yards – I ALLOWED Shevy to circle me about 15 times (could have been 25 – hopefully no one was counting!).

I know Shevy and I know what she was up to. This was not her usual circling to be messing. She had a goal it was the tree line that would house birds if only she were allowed to go look. I knew shortening the line – or starting over – would only prolong the inevitable. So I decided to wait her out. Shevy wanted to hunt – not track.

On her 15th circle – her head bobbed to the left on the track – I said "good girl – find it" and off she went! She never stopped. It was very fun – nice to know Shevy agreed it was perfect tracking conditions too.

We had one other spot where hunting crossed her mind. We had made 3 turns and were back to the dirt road. I knew we didn't cross the road – so we would either go left or right. I sure didn't know – but Shevy was sniffing the air – JUST across the road, maybe 50 yards away – a beautiful tree line. Even better than the first.

Someone else will have to tell you how long we lingered at that spot – as by now I was no longer capable of thought. Shevy finally turned to the right – and down a draw. Headed straight toward fantastic cover for quail. I was absolutely sure a whistle would blow any second.
