Board to Present Update to Standing Rules at August Meeting Proposal Includes Implementation of Test Worker Option

The Standing Rules are an accumulation of the decisions that the Club has made about its normal operations. They are available in the Yahoo Group files and can be changed by a vote of the Club at a regular meeting. The Board of Directors is discussing an important new addition - the Test Worker Option. Along with the recommendation on how to implement the Test Worker Option, the Board has reviewed the existing Standing Rules and plans to present items that they feel need to be changed, as well as items that need to be added based on decisions at prior Club meetings.

The major new item is the implementation of the Test Worker Option. As was mentioned in the last issue of *Tracks*, the AKC allows clubs to set aside a specific number of tracks in each test to be made available for a priority Worker Draw that is designed to be a reward for test workers from prior tests. If a club chooses to implement it, the AKC requires that the clubs themselves specify how those who can enter the Worker Draw are determined. There was a good discussion at the last meeting and in the following Board meeting. The Board wants to finalize its proposal and put it to the membership for a vote at the August meeting.

Along with the addition of the Test Worker Option, the Board decided to go back through the Standing Rules to clean them up and propose any changes they thought should be made. Thus they plan to propose a replacement for the Standing Rules at the August meeting.

Most of the changes are house-cleaning, but there is one significant change in addition to the Test Worker Option that the Board feels should be made. The Board feels that the record-keeping and process required to identify "Active Members" is not worth the benefit derived from it. It will be proposing that the entire section on "Membership" be eliminated, along with the process of identifying "Active" members. The purpose of requiring certain activities for a member to continue to be a Regular Member was to ensure that the Club had a quorum at its meetings. Quorums have not been a problem. Thus the Board will be recommending that club members be admitted as they request. If they plan to come to meetings and want to vote and/or hold office they should be Regular Members. If they just want to stay in the information loop, but don't really plan on coming to meetings or holding office, they should be Associate members. In addition, the Household membership will be for two *Regular* members (of course the dollar amount is the same as if it were two Associate members). No one's dues should change, but we feel quite a bit of reporting and bookkeeping will be eliminated.

This year the weather leading up to the test was <u>much</u> nicer to us. In 2016 nearby Decatur had over 4.5" of rain in the 3 weeks before our test. This year there was less than .33" of rain. The land actually drains very well and wasn't a problem this year for our tracklayers and teams in the field. The problem was getting everyone to the right place at the right time (and back). This year we had two designated drivers with BIG pickups for transportation, thanks to John Galbraith and Jackie Tinker.

Last year the tall grass and the rolling nature of the land combined with our short cross-track flags gave our cross-track layers a bit of difficulty. This year the grass was even taller, but we were ready. John and Pandora Galbraith had volunteered to make us new cross-track flags out of PVC (jointed for ease of storage no less). Not only was the flag taller, but the flag portion was brightly colored, with terrific decoration done by Pandora.





Also in 2016 our tent stayed grounded until about half-way through our meeting, when we had to temporarily adjourn the meeting to take it down or it would have been in the next county. This year we moved the tent to a location where we could strap it to the T-posts of a fence surrounding an old oil well. A line of storms moved through overnight between plotting day and test day. It was the greatest feeling early Sunday morning to drive over the ridge and see the port-o-potty and the tent still upright and in place. The tent stayed in place until we were through and ready to take it down.

Protective Footwear for Dogs in AKC Tracking Tests

From the Minutes of the May AKC Board meeting:

The Board reviewed a recommendation to allow protective footwear for dogs in AKC Tracking tests. On occasion, sites used for AKC Tracking tests have been found to have dangerous foxtail and thorny plants in them, as well as a potential to have lawn chemicals and broken glass. Because this change is a safety issue, the staff requested that the Board consider implementing the regulation change immediately. Following a motion by Mr. Gladstone, seconded by Dr. Battaglia the Board VOTED (unanimously; absent: Mr. Dok), to consider the matter at this meeting, waiving the usual notice requirements.

Following a motion from Mr. Gladstone, seconded by Mr. Powers, it was VOTED (unanimously; absent: Mr. Dok), to amend Chapter 2, Section 4, of the *Tracking Regulations* effective immediately.

Chapter 2. Regulations for Performance and Judging

Section 24. Protective Clothing. Dogs may wear a protective coat and/or footwear. If worn the coat, tracking harness and footwear must be put on in the presence of both judges.*



Accustom your dog to protective footwear this summer while you protect his paws from hot surfaces.

If the Test Worker Option is approved at the August meeting, vouchers would be given to workers at the November 2017 VST/TDU and going forward

The Test Secretary/Chair would make the final decision as to who gets a voucher and a record of the vouchers given would be kept with the Test Records

A worker can only get 1 entry into a Workers Draw for a test even if he/she volunteers for more than one job at a test

Vouchers will expire 2 years from the issue date

Vouchers are not transferable. They may be used by the worker for a dog that is owned, co-owned, or handled by the worker.

If there is no worker draw at a test, the voucher will be returned

The number of tracks set aside at a test for test workers is specified in the AKC Regulations, Amended to January 1, 2016 Section 17d.

Tracy Freeling moved that the Test Worker Option be added to the Standing Rules

Following discussion, Tracy amended the motion to read that the Board would draft a standing rule for the Test Worker Option to be voted on by the membership

The amended motion was seconded and the motion carried
